What have we been up to...

We are only a few weeks in and we have already been very busy, lots of animal crafts, looking at Artic and Antarctic animals in particular. Tying in nicely with the very cold weather we had! But this was a great opportunity to explore the ice that had appeared outside. Using various media to break it or melt it and more.

We've been singing animal themed songs a particular favourite being 'one little elephant balancing' and 'If you're a Giraffe and you know it' or our old favourite '5 little Monkeys jumping on the bed'

It will soon be time for us to book our Annual trip - this usually happens on a Thursday towards the end of June [Subject to availability] We book a coach and this is optional to travel together to our destination [subsidised by playgroup] and is exciting as many have not travelled by coach before. Or you can make your own way. Watch out for the finalised date and location.

Voluntary Contributions

The little brown envelopes are in the workbox now - Thanks to those who have returned or paid via BACS.

As a registered charity we have to manage our finances very carefully - families are often not aware that the money we receive from the government funding for your 'free hours' is much less than our hourly rate [we receive £5.14ph Gov funding - this is £2.36 less than our hourly fee] hence why we ask parents and families to support us with a termly voluntary contribution of £10, this money helps provide the lovely healthy snack your children enjoy-offering interesting alternatives like toast, bagels, pancakes for pancake day, foods to taste for Chinese New year, the amazing resources we use, ingredients for cooking and much more. We are very lucky to have such an amazing facility but owning our building means we have more costs than some other settings with ongoing maintenance and repairs. So if you are able to please do support us with the voluntary contribution. You can also pay this via BACS using the same account details that you use for paying your bill.

Easter Family Fun Event.

For those who are new to Playgroup we hold a yearly Easter Event - From 2-4pm on a Sunday 21st April, where

we have games, activities for the children, an egg Hunt, refreshments for adults and children, Guess the name of the Bunny to win a prize and much more. It is a lovely social event for families and children to get together.

We sell tickets in advance [limited numbers] these allow the children a number of activities included in the price. We also usually have a Watch out for more information nearer the time - but put the date in your Diary so not to miss out.

Sponsored Trike Ride:13th-17th May

This is our other main annual Fundraising event at Playgroup.

For this we ask the children to take part by pedaling, scooting, being pulled in a trolley or walk around the track on the playground. Whilst our Parents, Carer's gather sponsors from extended family, friends, work colleagues, neighbours - we don't mind who you ask! Either per lap or as a set amount. Most children manage around 10 laps.



Once they have taken part we issue them with a certificate stating how many laps they completed ready for you to collect the sponsor money.

Sponsor forms will be sent home a week or two before. As a registered charity we are also able to claim Gift Aid if you are a UK taxpay-

er and sign the forms [as they say in a popular supermarket every little helps]





End of Term Leavers Picnic - Friday 19th July

Weather permitting!, **All** families are welcome. This is a chance to catch up with other families and Staff, say our goodbyes to those leaving us for school and maybe arrange playdates in the summer break!

On the last day of term we hold a morning session ONLY then all children need to be accompanied by their parent/ grandparent for the picnic so all to arrive by 12noon. Bring a rug to sit on and your picnic lunch. There is no afternoon session that day - children will go home with you when the picnic is finished.

Sessions/Funding

Please remember if you are claiming the new 15 hours from April 2024 or 30 hours **YOU MUST** re-confirm eligibility <u>**TERMLY**</u> and have a valid code before the end of the month before a new term starts.

If you think you may be eligible for this in the **next term** please go onto the <u>childcare</u> <u>choices</u> website which explains all you need to know [the site has lots of other information about other forms of funding options too]. Again you **MUST** confirm eligibility and get your code before the start of a new term.

Recommended dates to apply for Spring Term - 15th Oct-30thNov/ Autumn term between 15th June-31st July/ Summer term 15th Jan-28th Feb.

Sessions are beginning to fill up with new children joining us , if you are thinking of increasing your sessions, adding extra sessions or extending to full days - please speak to us as soon as possible to check availability, —we book a term in advance. Summer term is usually our busiest.
